Dear Supporter:

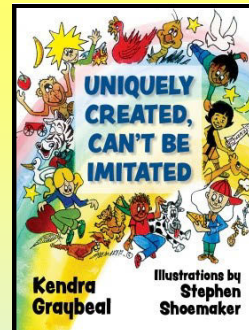

All Children Deserve to Be Loved, Nurtured and Safe

The NEST Alliance is aware that this is a very hard time for many families. The added stress and isolation can place a child at risk. Extended family members and the community are the first line of defense for child protection. We seek to continue to raise awareness during Child Abuse Prevention Month. This month and throughout the year, The NEST

Alliance encourages every individual and organization to play a role in making Ashe County a safe and nurturing place where all children, youth and families can be strong and thrive in our communities. Research shows that protective factors are present in healthy families. Promoting these factors is among the most effective ways

to reduce the risk of child abuse and neglect. According to the cdc.gov website, these factors include:

- Supportive family environment and social networks
- Concrete support for basic needs
- Nurturing parenting skills
- Stable family relationships and

child monitoring

- Parental employment
- Adequate housing
- Access to health care and social services
- Caring adults outside the family who can serve as role models or mentors

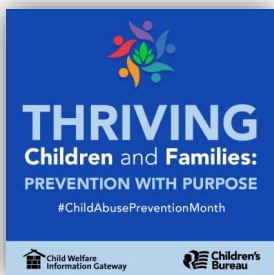

She tied a **blue ribbon** to the antenna of her car as a way to remember him and to alert her community to the tragedy of **child abuse**.
