Information for Our Reader

- Some May 2021 statistics shared during our Golf Tournament: 76 children in foster care (including ages 18-21); 25 foster homes; 41 children placed outside Ashe County; 19 Guardians ad Litem who serve as "a voice for a child" as the child enters the foster care system in our county.
- The NEST Alliance is strengthening our NEST Kids Program following the pandemic by working on increasing the scope and impact of our weekly NEST Kids Program.
- We are actively seeking alliances that can address the issues that are causing unstable home environments for children and prevent the abuse and neglect of a child in Ashe County. We live in a beautiful place as shown in the view of Mt. Jefferson above. We believe that our environments for local children need to be just as beautiful and as safe as possible.
- May we never grow weary in Ashe County of finding ways for a child not just to survive, but to thrive.

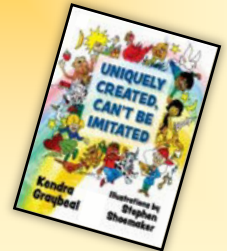
The NEST Alliance Resale Booth Has Moved to a Corner Booth at Martha Mae's Emporium
