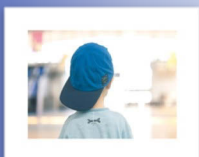
April 2024 Child Abuse Prevention Month

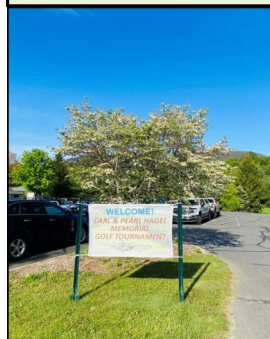


5 Years of Support from Skyline National Bank

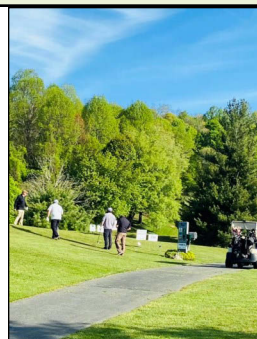

is set aside to show appreciation and gratitude to foster parents across the nation.

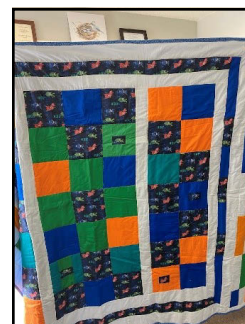
Foster care intends to provide a safe environment for children and youth who temporarily cannot live with their families. On any given day in the U.S., 400,000 children are in foster care.

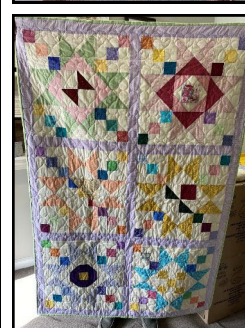
